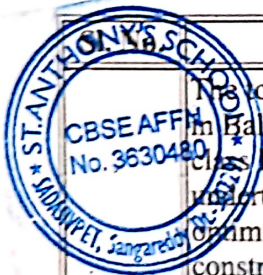
Sir/Madam,

This is with reference to school application on the subject cited above. I am directed to convey approval of the Board for Fresh Affiliation Up to Secondary Level as per details given below :

The school is directed to ensure that :

- 1 The total number of sections of Bal Vatika shall be restricted to 06 (02 sections each in Bal Vatika I, II & III respectively). The total number of sections of the school from Class 1 to 10th shall be restricted to 18 only. School is having sufficient space and has undertaken to construct more classrooms of 500 sqr ft size within 03 months. The maximum number of the students shall be restricted to 40 in each section and till construction of the required number and size of classrooms, the intake in sections shall be 32 so that each student has floor area of 1 sqr ft as per norms. School shall not increase the number of permitted sections and any increase of sections in future shall be subject to specific approval of the Board on the basis of the request of the school as per affiliation bye law and availability of class rooms of greater than 500 sq ft dimension. The school shall upload the compliance on construction of required size of classrooms (500 sqr ft) and shall also upload an undertaking to start Bal vatika from coming session on SARAS portal within 03 months.
- 2 The composite science lab has plastic stools for seating facilities which are not acceptable and safe and are hazardous due to heating facility and inflammable chemicals. Hence school is directed to follow the Board guidelines vide circular no 11/2022 9SoPs on labs, library and sports and upgrade the lab with recommended



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| | infrastructure and safety measures and upload the compliance on SARAS portal within 03 months. |
| 3 | The maths lab is under sized and under stocked and has not been laid out as per Board guidelines and SoPs vide circular no 11/2022. It is temporarily arranged in classroom with small tables and modules/charts/instrument just displayed over it. There are no proper work stations, space to conduct the project/module work etc. School is directed to upgrade the math lab as per board guidelines (circular no 11/2022) with recommended infrastructure and facilities and upload compliance on SARAS portal within 03 months. |
| 4 | The library is under stocked. Most of the library collection of 3000 books includes specimen copies and text books. School has around 900 students and library collection is not sufficient as per the Board guidelines. School is directed to follow the SoPs vide circular no 11/2022 and upgrade the library with proper library collection including Information Communication Technology Infrastructure as per the Board guidelines and upload the compliance within 03 months on SARAS portal. |
| 5 | The CwSN toilets are not made available each floor. School building is ground + 3 upper floors. The CwSN toilets are available only at ground and first floor. Further the available toilets are also not maintained properly with recommended infrastructure and facilities to make the campus CwSN accessible as per statutory provisions and the Board guidelines vide circular no 05/2023. School is directed to make provisions for CwSN toilets at each floor separately for boys and girls with required facilities and upload the compliance on SARS portal with video link within 03 months. |
| 6 | The general toilets including the CwSN are not kept properly clean and hygienic. Toilets general staff are also not maintained properly. School is directed to keep the toilets clean for safety and hygienic conditions as per rule 4.7.2 of the affiliation bye laws and upload the compliance on SARAS portal within 03 months. |
| 7 | The outdoor playground and infrastructure is not properly developed. There is litter, garbage and construction material scattered in the playground with uneven land raising safety and hygiene concern for the students. School shall keep the campus clean and shall upload the compliance with video link on SARS portal within 03 months. |
| 8 | The school shall conduct training of its teachers with CoE Vijayawada, CBSE and submit the compliance on SARAS portal within 03 months . |

Compliance of the above mentioned points shall be submitted within 03 months on the SARAS portal. Failure to comply within the prescribed time shall invite financial penalty @ Rs. 50,000/- every month until compliance is submitted and shall debar the school from filling the registration and LOC of students class IX to class XII , as the case may be.

The approval of the Board as mentioned above, is subject to the following conditions:-

1. The school shall be responsible for its genuineness of the documents/ data/ information uploaded by the school. In case of any discrepancies, action will be initiated against the school as per Affiliation Bye -Laws-2018.
2. The school shall follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned.
3. The School shall apply online for extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws.
4. The school shall go through the provision of Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and subsequent amendment therein as well as circulars and guidelines /instructions issued by the Board time to time and keep a copy thereof for reference purpose and is also advised to regularly visit CBSE websites i.e., <http://cbseacademic.nic.in/> & <http://cbse.nic.in/> for updates.
5. The school shall renew mandatory certificates from time to time.

6. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity /activity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. All legal expenses incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances, shall be borne by the school.
7. Concerned Regional Office is requested to create new email id of school as per direction issued by controller of examination. This E Mail ID is used for communication with CBSE only.
8. The school shall not remove the documents and videography links in the mandatory disclosure section of its website.
9. The school shall follow the SOPs of the Board for its Laboratories, Library and sports facilities issued by the Board vide circular no 11 dated 04.10.2022.

If the compliance is not submitted with in the stipulated 3 months , the Board may enhance the penalty amount and debar the schools from filling up registration/LOC details of students of classes IX to XII, as the case may be, in the next academic session i.e. 2024-25.
